SHARPES MULTIFEED NUTS/PELLETS is a GMO Free multipurpose ration formulated to be suitable to be fed to sheep, cattle, deer, goats and alpacas. Multifeed improves condition and productivity in animals. An excellent addition to ruminant livestock during periods where nutrient demands are higher or during periods of the year where feed is short.

Sharpes Multifeed is formulated with high quality, locally sourced ingredients, to provide an excellent source of protein to promote healthy growth.

KEY BENEFITS:

- Ingredients processed into a nut or pellet, reduces wastage, and increases utilisation
- Lower starch levels than raw grains reducing the risk of acidosis

BAG SIZES: 10kg, 20kg, 1/2 tonne and 1 tonne bags.

Multifeed is also available as a pellet, ideal for automatic feeders.

INGREDIENTS SELECTED FROM: Locally sourced grains and cereals, limestone, molasses, macro and trace minerals, vitamins.

TYPICAL ANALYSIS (approximate on a dry matter basis):

Crude Protein 12% ME 12 MJ/kg

STORAGE: To maintain quality please store product in a cool, dry and vermin free environment. Best fed within six months of production.

FEED RECOMMENDATIONS:

TOP TIP: Multifeed is best fed in a long line, as this reduces competition and wastage. Always ensure an adequate amount of fresh clean water and forage is available to animals at all times.

Introduce feed gradually to minimise the risk of acidosis and ensure animals have access to clean, fresh water.

Sharpes Multifeed is a high energy feed that when fed pre-tupping can be very beneficial to ewe flock performance. Good nutrition helps support high ovulation and conception rates. The benefits of a high energy supplementary pre tupping can be seen all the way through to weaning weights of both Ewes and Lambs.









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- Feeding rates depend on many varying factors, such as **pasture availability** and quality, and the age and condition of the sheep. This can make it difficult to apply an arbitrary rule for feeding, as every feed situation, farmer and farm is different.
- To see the greatest benefits of a pre tupping supplementary feed, begin feeding 4 to 6 weeks prior to tupping and throughout the tupping period.
- Introduce Multifeed slowly at around 50g/head/ day for the first few days, then increase gradually over the next week to 250g/head/day.
- If feeding lighter ewes and hoggets, then allow another week to increase up to 350g/head/day.

CATTLE: 1–4 kg/day

LIGHTER EWES/HOGGETS: 350g/head/day.

RAMS AND EWES: 200g/head/day.

DEER: Adult 0.5-2 kg/day, fawns 100-500gms/day

 $\underline{\text{GOATS}}$: Adult 0.5-2 Kg/ day, Kids 50–200gms/day

ALPACA: Up to 150gms per day

CAUTION: Not to be fed to any other animal species than those recommended on the label.
