3+	from 3 days of age, starting with small quantities. Once adjusted, feed ad lib up to 200g/	Introduce Lamb Sweetmix in the early days of milk feeding in small quantities. Once the lamb has adjusted to the Sharpes Lamb Sweetmix they can then transition on to Sharpes Lamb Pellets.

TOP TIP: Always ensure that lambs have access to fresh, clean water.

This feed contains Rumensin[™] 20% Millmix[™] in the lamb feed at a rate of 0.5 kg premix per tonne of feed as an aid in the prevention and control of coccidiosis caused by Eimeria bovis and Eimeria zuernii. This is the equivalent of 100 ppm (mg/kg) of monensin active ingredient in the lamb feed.

Rumensin[™] 20% MillMix[™] is a registered pursuant to the ACVM Act 1997, A009107. See www.nzfsa.govt.nz/acvm for registration conditions.

CONTRAINDICATIONS: Do not treat sheep with products containing erythromycin, tiamulin or oleandomycin while using Rumensin[™] 20% Millmix[™].

CAUTION: Do not use on horses or dogs as fatal toxicosis may result. Ensure recommended doses are not exceeded. Care must be exercised when feeding concurrently with other antimicrobials.

It is an offence for users of this product to cause residues exceeding the relevant MRL in the Food Notice: Maximum Residue Levels for Agricultural Compounds.

WITHHOLDING PERIOD:

Cattle: Meat: Nil, Milk: Nil

Sheep and Goats – Meat: Nil, Milk: Milk intended for human consumption must be discarded during treatment for not less than 35 days following the last treatment.
